The children waved goodbye to Santa as he climbed into his sleigh and took off into the sky. Santa waved back and then disappeared into the night.





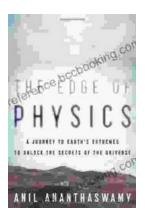
