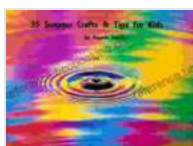


20. Perler Bead Creations

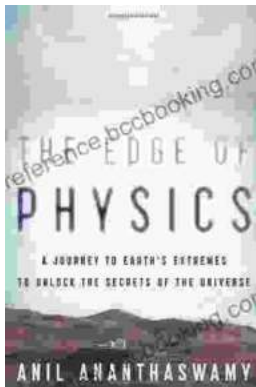
