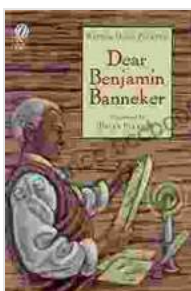

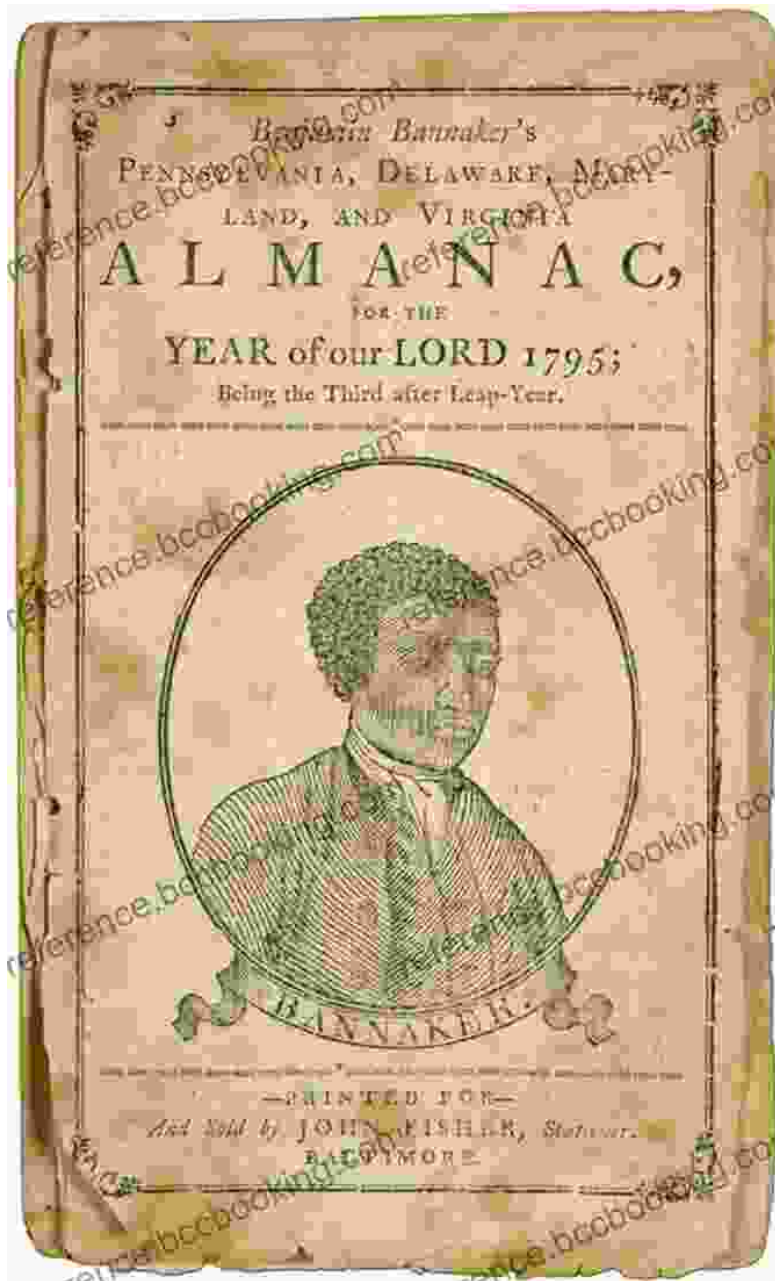

I can tell with truth that no body wishes more ardently to see a good system commenced for raising the condition both of their body & mind to that it ought to be, as just as the inhumanity of their present existence, and their existence which cannot be neglected, will admit. I have taken the liberty of sending your address to Messrs de la Harpe, Secretary of the Academy of Sciences at Paris, and to the Philanthropic Society, because I considered it as a government to which your whole colour had a right for their just freedom against the doubts which have been entertained of them. I am with great esteem Sir

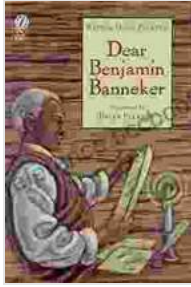

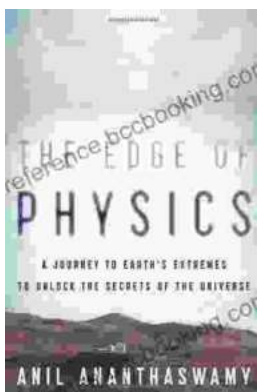
