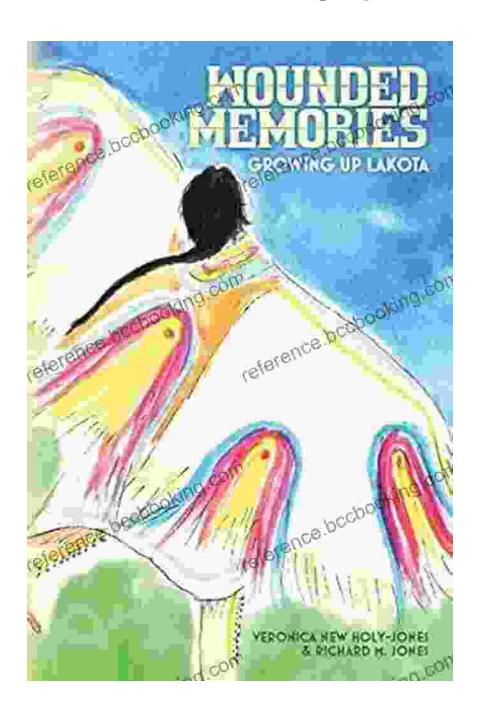
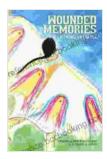

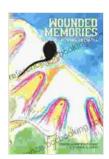
About the Author

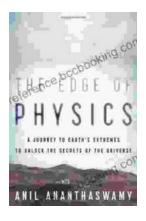
